



This pertains to the hiring of Teacher I Items in IPEd implementing schools. DepEd Order No. 32 s. 2015 (DO 32 s. 2015) or Adopting the Indigenous Peoples Education Curriculum Framework reiterates the right of indigenous learners to culturally rooted, and responsive basic education. It also provides the mandate to establish institutionalized partnerships between indigenous communities, and schools. A part of this mandate is that Schools Divisions Offices define the schools within the division that cater to specific indigenous communities.

In line with ensuring culturally rooted and responsive basic education is ensuring that the teachers that provide learning delivery to indigenous learners are rooted in the key concepts of indigenous peoples' education, and the cultural nuances of the community. This is supported by DepEd Order No. 50, s. 2016 (DO 50 s. 2016) entitled *Hiring Guidelines for Teacher I Positions in Schools Implementing Indigenous Peoples Education Effective School Year 2016-2017*. May it be noted that the guidelines under DO 50 s. 2016 apply to Teacher I applicants who are to be assigned to schools who cater to specific indigenous communities as determined by the schools division. Thus, all Teacher I that teach in schools who cater to specific indigenous communities should have been evaluated per DO 50 s. 2016.

In cases wherein the evaluations have already been completed, please ensure that the teachers to be deployed in schools who cater to specific indigenous communities should have at least been consulted with the indigenous communities' customary elders/leaders.
