PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES FOR THE LA NIÑA PHENOMENON

This has reference to the issued Regional Disaster Risk Reduction & Management Council IX (RDRRMC IX) Memo No. 27, s. 2024 dated May 21, 2024 emphasizing the PAGASA El Niño / La Niña Watch Advisory No. 11. The said advisory has articulated a 60% chance of La Niña developing during the months of June-July-August (JJA) 2024 season.

With this, Division Offices must issue advisories to schools to implement suitable preparedness and response measures against the effects of La Niña and other accompanying weather disturbances.

Division DRRM Coordinators are also expected to monitor the schools that experience frequent flooding and/or have occurrence of landslides and provide technical support to mitigate the impact of weather disturbance on the educational facilities, learning materials, computer equipment, and other school properties.



Precautionary Measures for the Effects of La Niña in the AOR

References: DOST-PAGASA ENSO El Niño Advisory No. 11/La Niña Watch dtd May 06, 2024

In reference to PAGASA ENSO Advisory (EI Niño Advisory No. 11 / La Niña Watch) issued last May 06, 2024, a transition to ENSO-neutral conditions is anticipated during the April-May-June (AMJ) to May-June-July (MJJ) 2024 season.

However, there is a 60% chance for La Niña to develop during the June-July-August 2024 season. As stated in the May 2024 Outlook, the weather systems that may affect the country for the month are easterlies, High Pressure Areas (HPAs), localized thunderstorms, ITCZ, LPAs and one (1) or two (2) tropical cyclones that may develop inside / enter the PAR

Hence, with reference to the potential weather systems that may affect our AOR and the rest of the country, all RDRRMC IX member-agencies, stakeholders, partners and Local Government Units through their Local DRRM Offices, are hereby strongly enjoined to undertake the following preparedness actions and precautionary measures:

RDRRMC IX member-agencies

- Participate in virtual Pre-Disaster Risk Assessment (PDRA) and other related meetings, as needed
- Response Cluster members to conduct resource inventory and stockpiling
- All concerned agencies to coordinate with OCD IX for measures to be undertaken in preparation for the rainy season.

LGUs

- Closely monitor the warning and other advisories issued by surveillance agencies.
- Undertake and implement science and evidence-based decisions in your areas of responsibility in the conduct of PDRA, as needed
- Prepare critical facilities and services
- Maximize the utilization of the Local DRRM Fund
- Adhere to the LISTO Protocol of the DILG, if applicable
- Impose pre-emptive evacuation as

Monitor moderated slopes with thick soil overburden and areas underlain by old landslide deposits. Be vigilant in monitoring for signs of imminent landslide, especially in areas that has high antecedent rainfall.
