



The ANCM aims to receive reports from the National President and the National Treasurer, elect four (4) regular members of the National Executive Board (NEB), ratify any proposed amendments to the BSP by-laws (if any), conduct the National Court of Honor and other awarding ceremonies, and discuss other business as may properly come before the meeting.
3. The Awarding Ceremonies of the Tribute to Scoutmaster, Outstanding Local Council / Regional Chairpersons and Outstanding Local Council / Regional Commissioners are ancillary events.
4. The target participants of the National Council are composed of the following: a) BSP NEB Members; b) DepEd Regional Directors; c) School Division Superintendents; d) Local Council Executive Members; and e) other local officials representing the 127 Local Councils of the BSP throughout the country.
5. The participants from the DepEd are allowed to attend **on official business**. Travel expenses to be incurred by participating DepEd officials and teachers involved in Scouting will be charged to local funds, subject to its availability, and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.


