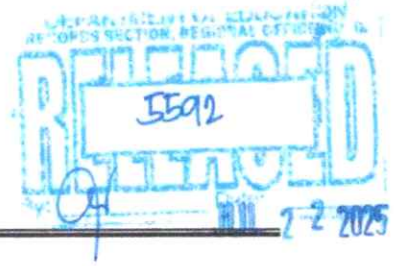

5. Expenses relative to these activities shall be charged to 2025 ALS Program Support Funds, Division/School MOOE, and LGU Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

DepEd Officials participating in these activities will be granted service credits if the said activity will fall on a holiday, Saturday and Sunday pursuant to the guidelines specified in **DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003** (*Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credit of Teachers*) and *Compensatory Time-Off (CTO)* per **CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004** (*Non-Monetary Renumeration for Overtime Services*), whichever is appropriate and applicable.
