DepEd Officials participating in these activities will be granted service credits if the said activity will fall on a holiday, Saturday and Sunday pursuant to the guidelines specified in **DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003** (*Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credit of Teachers*) and Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) per **CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004** (*Non-Monetary Renumeration for Overtime Services*), whichever is appropriate and applicable.
