- Attached are the Modernization Plan for the National Assessment Systems for Basic Education (NASBE) Program and the Regional Budget Allocations from Bureau Education Assessment (BEA), Education Assessment Division (EAD), signed and approved by Kevin Karl P. Santos, PhD., Director IV.
- The NASBE Modernization Plan aims to address the Bureau's pressing concern regarding the delayed release of the national assessment results, particularly to the DepEd field offices. Relative to this modernization plan, ICT equipment like the hardware scanner with Optical Mark Recognition (OMR) Software and a Desktop Computer will be procured.
- A provision of capacity building and training-workshop will also be provided to both RO and SDO on how to utilize the Hardware Scanner with OMR Software installed on desktop computers. This training will be offered by the winning service provider and co-facilitated by the Central Office.
- In line with this, the Regional Office will take the lead in the procurement of the ICT equipment to be distributed to the Schools Division Offices. The allocation of the NABSE ICT equipment per SDO shall be based on the cluster category designed by the Education Assessment Division, Central Office. Below are the appropriations of the ICT equipment per Schools Division Offices:

#### Modernization Plan for the National Assessment Systems for Basic Education (NASBE) Programs

#### Introduction

The mandate of the Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA) is to develop and manage a harmonized and standardized assessment mechanism for student learning outcomes, teacher effectiveness, leadership and management competencies, and education system efficiency and effectiveness. BEA also provides policy recommendations based on assessment results and research to enhance curriculum, learning delivery, teacher quality, and education management, thereby improving the quality of basic education.

The Bureau comprises two divisions: the Education Assessment Division (EAD) and the Education Research Division (ERD). ERD is responsible for conducting research based on the results of the national assessment programs. EAD, on the other hand, is responsible for developing, managing, and implementing assessments for students, teachers, and school leaders at the national level. The national assessment encompasses 17 DepEd Regional Offices (ROs), 228 Schools Division Offices (SDOs), and 119,348 schools, with an estimated total of 8,404,010 examinees across the country.

#### Assessment Practices

The Bureau typically contracts service providers for the following Lots:

Lot	Activity
1	Printing of Test Booklets (TBs) and Non-Classified Materials (NCMs)
2	Printing of Scannable Answer Sheets (SASs) and School Headers (SH) and processing assessment results, which involves designing and printing SASs and SH, batching, sorting, processing, and generating statistical data outputs, and printing of Certificates of Rating (CORs)
3	Delivery and retrieval of Test Materials (TMs) (Test Booklets, Scannable Answer Sheet, School Header, and Non-Classified Materials) from the 17 DepEd ROs.

Logistical Issues and Concerns: The retrieval of TMs from the field offices can be time-consuming, particularly when some SDOs have not completed their accounting of test materials. At times, Division Testing Coordinators (DTCs) or their authorized representative may be unreachable by the service provider, or delays may occur due to acts of nature, such as typhoons, earthquakes, and high heat indices, which could lead to the suspension of classes.

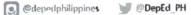
These logistical issues and concerns have a significant impact on the release of assessment results to the field offices. The delayed release of assessment results

prevents the field offices from developing learning interventions to address learners' academic weaknesses.

#### NASBE Modernization Plan

The NASBE Modernization Plan aims to address the Bureau's pressing concern regarding delayed release of national assessment results, particularly to the DepEd field offices (e.g., 16 ROs and 217 SDOs). The Decentralization of Digitized Assessment Package for the NASBE Modernization Plan includes the following: Hardware Scanner with Optical Mark Recognition (OMR) Software, and Desktop Computer.

With the NASBE Modernization Plan, the harvesting or gathering of learners' responses from the SAS will be decentralized. This means that the designated assessment staff, in collaboration with the ICT staff within the RO or SDO, will complete the preliminary tasks of data management, such as sorting, batching, scanning of the SAS, and data cleaning. After completing the preliminary tasks, the processed raw responses shall be submitted to the Bureau for processing and generation of assessment results at the national level.

#### Allocation and Estimated Cost per Unit

The allocation of the digitized assessment package per SDO shall be based on the cluster category designed by the Education Assessment Division. The estimated unit cost shall be based on the market study completed in January 2025.

#### Capacity Building for the Assessment Technical Working Group (TWG) Members from the Regional and Division Offices

TWG members will be given a capacity-building and training workshop on how to utilize the Hardware Scanner with OMR Software installed on desktop computers. This training will be offered by the winning service provider and co-facilitated by the Bureau.
